



Wrens - Sharing, love each other, cuddles, speak nicely, kind hands & feet

Kingfishers - Play together, make you smile when you're sad, show courage, show respect

Robins - Kind words, safe feet, shows respect, kind hands, shares with you, listens to you, helps you, smiles

Swifts - Listens, stand up for you, honest, takes turns, includes everyone, shares, always helps, kind

**Safeguarding Pupils at St Paul's**  
**What makes a good friend?**

Sparrows - Generous, apologises, helps, shows respect, supportive, kind, caring, kind hands, holds doors open, includes people

Finches - Listens, sensible, kind, always there, sharing, plays nicely, respectful, smiles, trust, helps

Firecrests - Supportive, listens, forgiving, respectful, caring, honest, shares, cheers you up, kind, plays with you, always there for you, stick up for you, won't hurt you

Owls - Kind, hopeful, joyful, cheer you up, trusted, accepting, nice, respectful, encourages you, loyal, don't judge.



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Wrens - Tell the teachers, tell an adult, tell my mummy, tell them 'I don't like it', tell a friend

Kingfishers - Say 'no thank you', say 'I don't like it', tell a teacher, walk away, tell an adult, play with someone else, tell my mummy

Robins - Ignore them, walk away, tell a teacher, not play with them, say 'stop', don't say anything back to them, find someone else to play with, help them calm down

Swifts - Stand up for myself, say 'please stop that you are being unkind', walk away and play with someone else, ask them if they are being a good friend, don't join in with their behaviour, ask them to not treat me like that

**Safeguarding Pupils at St Paul's**  
**What would you do if another pupil wasn't being a good friend?**

Sparrows - Small problem try and sort yourself, big problem ask a teacher for help, help them make better choices, tell a trusted adult, talk to them and try and calm them down, remind them to take deep breaths

Finches - Ignore them so you don't get upset, walk away and play with someone else, tell one of your 5 trusted adults, be brave and tell them to stop, tell the teacher

Firecrests - Tell a trusted adult, tell your mum or dad, stand up for yourself, tell a teacher, tell them to stop

Owls - Tell a trusted adult, tell a teacher, play with someone else, ignore the behaviour, stay away from them, tell a parent.



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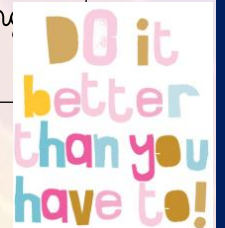
Wrens - We learn about: sharing, letting everyone join in, listening, saying please & thank you  
Kingfishers - Mrs Dennis talks about being kind, PSHE, we talk about it in a circle, we have a 'rules' wall  
Robins - Being respectful - Jigsaw charter, how to be kind in PSHE, in stories, going to support others, the teachers teach us how to be supportive.  
Swifts - We learn about being honest, being positive influence, inviting children to play, not being jealous, including everyone, being gentle & kind, having respect.

**Safeguarding Pupils at St Paul's**  
**What do you learn in the curriculum about what makes a good friend?**

Sparrows - We learn about British Values, being kind, telling the truth, including everyone, showing empathy, being fair, saying sorry, helping others  
Finches - We learn to listen, we learn to be polite and not answer back, we learn about trusted adults, we learn to be resilient, we learn how to be kind & helpful and to keep our hands to ourselves, we learn how to play.  
Firecrests - We learn about trust, not spreading rumours, not pressuring people, not being physical with anyone, PSHE, peer pressure, helping each other  
Owls - We learn about being friendly and kind, communicating kindly, acceptance, listening well, being friendly and we learn about the school values.



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Wrens - Tell a teacher, tell mummy/daddy/nanny/grandad, we would be sad, tell friends, tell police, tell brothers/sisters, tell police.

Kingfishers - Tell trusted adult, tell teacher, talk to an adult, find a friend

Robins - Shout for mummy/daddy, tell the teacher, tell the parents, tell the police, walk away and play with someone else, don't talk to strangers or listen to them.

Swifts - Walk away, tell an adult, tell Mrs. Dennis, tell a relative, tell a parent, tell a teacher, walk away.

**Safeguarding Pupils at St Paul's**  
**What would you do if someone out of school makes you feel unsafe?**

Sparrows - Tell mum/dad, shout for help, move away and go somewhere else, run away, go to someone or somewhere I do feel safe, tell an adult, tell a trusted adult, go to a neighbour, go home, change the direction you are going

Finches - Don't trust the, , scream and run away, tell parents, tell one of my 5 trusted adults, shout no loudly, run to a safe place, don't talk to them

Firecrests - Tell your parents, tell the teacher, tell safeguarding team, run away, tell a trusted adult, shout

Owls - Tell trusted adult, inform an adults, tell a parent, tell a friend, ignore them



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
