



Safeguarding Pupils at St Paul's What do you know about staying safe online?

Kingfishers - We don't watch YouTube, Mummy is with me, do not click the buttons.

Robins - Don't message strangers, don't share password, don't play with strangers, if something bad happens tell your parents, if something pops up don't press it, don't use the internet without an adult, only go online when grown ups are around

Swifts - Talk to an adult if something worries you, don't follow advice from someone on the internet, if someone talks to you on an iPad, don't answer and tell an adult, don't give anyone your address, never tell anyone details about you, only go on sites that you parents or teacher say you can, don't go on YouTube - you don't know what you might see.

Sparrows - Ask your Mum & Dad who you can talk to, don't give out personal information, tell your parents if anyone is mean to you online, ask permission to do certain tasks, don't send pictures, don't buy anything your parents don't know about, don't open letters you are unsure of.

Finches - Do not talk/reply to strangers, do not share personal information, tell one of your 5 trusted adults, do not share photos or usernames ever

Firecrests - If someone asks you your name or for personal information - don't tell them, don't share passwords, don't talk to strangers online - always ignore and tell an adult

Owls - Take a moment to think - is it a scam, is someone is rude - block and report, don't talk to strangers, don't respond, never send

Safeguarding Pupils at St Paul's What would do if you felt unsafe online?



Kingfishers - Tell Daddy, tell trusted adults, tell Mrs Wingrove

Robins - Sit with Mum when online, press 'no' on your iPad, let Mum sort it out, turn it off, don't play that game anymore, tell someone who is with you, tell Mummy, Daddy or a teacher

Swifts - Talk to your adult at home, don't reply to people you don't know, switch the iPad off and tell an adult, tell a teacher

Sparrows - Tell an adult straight away, hang up, ask for help, tell mum & dad maybe they can block or delete that person

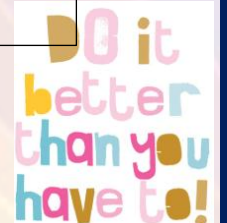
Finches - Turn it off, tell a trusted adult, SMART rules, block the player, leave the game immediately

Firecrests - Tell Mum or Dad, block the person, tell a teacher, turn off the device, ignore and don't respond

Owls - Tell a trusted adult, block and report them, stay off the APP, come off the internet, tell an adult, ignore all personal questions

Safeguarding Pupils at St Paul's
Do you feel safe when using
technology at home and at school?
Why / why not?

Kingfishers - Yes on iPads and we use Topmarks

Robins - Yes - I sit with Mum, I have my own safe account, No at home I use an iPad alone and messages might pop up, at school yes as we taught how to be safe, at school the iPads are safe, at school there is a teacher watching us

Swifts - At home there is always an adult close by, there are always adults close by to help if something goes wrong, at school adults always help us feel safe and somethings are blocked so we feel safe

Sparrows - Yes, there is always someone to help if we have any problems. Not always at home as anyone can go on an iPad - my parents could put a lock on it.

Finches - Yes because of the security settings at home and school. Firewalls, parent controls, and trusted adults are always nearby.

Firecrests - Yes because we know what to do if we feel unsafe, controls and blocks on devices.

Owls - Yes because we can always speak to trusted adults in the room, trackers, restrictions and sites prevented, At school yes because there is no social media.

What have you been taught about
how to deal with strangers or
inappropriate message online?*

Kingfishers - Tell and adult

Robins - Tell Mummy or Daddy, turn the iPad off, don't answer back, tell who you are with, 'stop, close. Tell', don't play with them anymore, press 'no', don't talk to strangers.

Swifts - Don't reply, tell an adult - Mum, Dad, Grandparents, teachers

Sparrows - Tell a trusted adult, don't say mean things back, if you are on your own - leave the message and don't open it, tell someone straight away, ask Mum & Dad to block messages from people you don't know

Finches - Block and report, tell a trusted adult, leave the game, do not text back, do not talk to strangers online

Firecrests - Block the person and tell a trusted adult

Owls - Report and block them, tell a trusted adult, don't share anything, leave the chat, don't trust them, never click on links, don't share personal information.
