

## Snow work ideas for Finches:

Read through the activity ideas below and choose one (or more) to complete at home.

### Snow Scientist Challenge

Task ideas:

1. **Measure & compare**
  - Measure how deep the snow is (using a ruler, spoon, or even fingers).
  - Put a small bowl of snow inside and time how long it takes to melt. You could put several bowls of snow in different places in your house and see which one melts the fastest.
  - Measure how much water is left after it melts.
2. **Record results**
  - Draw a labelled picture.
  - Create a simple table or bar chart to show results.

### Snow Art (No paint needed!)

Task ideas:

- Build a mini snow sculpture
- Make a snow picture using twigs, leaves, or stones
- Draw the snowy scene from their window or take a photo of a snowy scene.

### Snow Poetry

Task ideas:

#### **Snow Senses Poem**

- **Sight:** *Snow looks like...*
- **Sound:** *Snow sounds like...*
- **Touch:** *Snow feels like...*
- **Smell:** *Snow smells like...*
- **Taste (optional):** *Snow tastes like...*

Example starter:

Snow looks like glitter on the ground,  
Snow sounds like silence breaking,  
Snow feels like icy feathers...

#### **Simile Snow Poem**

Write a 6–8 line poem using “like” or “as”.

Examples:

- *Snow is like a white blanket*
- *Snowflakes dance like ballerinas*

 **Snowflake Shape Poem**

Children write a poem in the shape of a **snowflake** or **snowman**.



 **Snow Acrostic Poem**

Use **SNOW**, **SNOWMAN** or **WINTER** down the page.

Example:

**S**ilent skies falling  
**N**ight wrapped in white  
**O**nce green fields vanish  
**W**onder fills the air
